Opening remarks by CS:

In the opening remarks, CS, Sri. M V Satyanarayana informed that CHT, NLR, KNL new DECs and the first CNTX-S body was formed. There would be a meeting with the CGMT-AP on 25.06.2024 and 9 members comprising of CEC & DS, CNTX-S along with the chairman will be attending it.

In view of the existing membership window from 16.06.2024 to 15.07.2024, all the DEC members should meet & speak with all the members for driving them for achieving maximum membership. The detailed list of all the members will be shared shortly.

We have already opposed 15% transfers of the sanctioned strength in view of the on-going priority projects in the circle. Like CO-ND longstanding transfers, the circle should implement Intra circle transfers based on long standing years of the employees rather than 15% of sanctioned strength. The CGM & GM(HR) are co-operative and the CEC is confident to take any issue with the management.CGM has assured to discuss with AIGETOA before issuing transfer orders.

Chairman:

Chairman, Sri. K. Srinivas Rao expressed that there are burning issues with the TIP partners & felt that there is need to design clear guidelines for the implementation of ONE-Network.

VIZIANAGARAM OA:

There should be exemption to the genuine cases from the long standing Intra Circle transfers. The Tx wing should be strengthened. There should be rotational transfers from indoor (after 3 years) to outdoor field units for a healthy working environment. One Network should be implemented in true spirit. Non-performers should be identified & targeted.

VISAKAPATNAM BA:

Intra circle transfer should be completed within this month as The Intra BA transfers held up due to delay of intra circle transfers. 15% Intra circle transfers should be opposed. Genuine cases like spouse grounds should be exempted. The Core link performance is very poor & leasing in fibers from other TSPs should be explored.700 MHz is affecting the services in the saturation project due to handset compatibility issue. IPMS should be practical. FTTH back bone should be strengthened.

RAJAHMUNDRY BA:

The members are complaining about the effect of Intra circle transfers on the juniors rather than seniors.

ELURU BA:

Already submitted list of to be exempted cases to CS with the relevant supporting documents. Transparency should be maintained in Long-standing Intra circle transfers. BTS infra is ready & Core n/w time frame should be fixed. GGSN to be established at VJW. Immunity on transfers should be implemented as per CO guidelines.

VIJAYAWADA BA:

There is threat that 4 out of 44 would leave from the membership due to transfer issues. Only 4 members in one-network and are for reporting purpose only. The DE/AGMs are threatening the members on the name of transfers. Instead of 15% Intra circle transfers, staff balancing should be on demand basis. Assured to achieve 50 members count in this membership drive.TIP meetings are not conducted by management & insisting for 1 OLTE/month. EoI will be floated for new OLT additions and Necessary instructions will be issued by Circle office to BAs .20 sites are ready w/o media & are idle due to poor coordination b/w CM & Tx units. MAAN should be implemented immediately. Staff and vehicle shortage in O&I to be resolved. Inter circle transfer order of Smt. Chandrakala to CHTD will be taken up with CHQ for change of posting from CHTD to TLNG.

CIRCLE OFFICE, VIJAYAWADA:

. 15% Intra circle transfers should be opposed. Expressed concerned on the pending Inter circle transfers.

GUNTUR BA:

GM is threatening the employees on the theft cases. Requested to take up the issue to stop the salary recovery from the executive Sri. M V Rao, SDE. Soft corner on TIPs by management. Success is attributed to TIPs & failures are attributed to employees. Instead of 15% Intra circle transfers, stay based transfers should be implemented.

CNTX-S AP CIRCLE:

Thanked the CS for forming new CNTX-S body. Submitted that they are in touch with all the members.3 JTOs posed in CNTX, Management promised for reposting in AP circle after 6 months. Excess postings of AGMs in CNTX-S AP Circle(6Nos). Other issues will be submitted to CS shortly.

NELLORE BA:

Just crossed 20 yrs cases should be dropped from intra circle transfers & genuine cases like spouse cases should be exempted. NLR DFS immunity should be taken up with Circle administration. SDE Subramanyam Transfer case should be taken up for retention for 1 year. FTTH TIP issues should be taken up with management for their resolution.

CHITTOOR BA:

Regular DE/AGMs should be posted. Sought clarification on DGM/AO to CAO promotions. Procurement of armored cable tracer/locators to be taken up immediately. Shortage of store in STR should be taken up with the STR CGM.OTT should be incorporated in the FTTH bundling plans for better promotions. 4G Core network to be installed as early as possible. 4G with existing core have issues with BW. Requested to speak to Jharkhand CS regarding posting of Sri. JAGAN AGM.

ANANTAPUR BA:

TIP issues are similar as submitted by other BAs. Performance monitoring clause in FTTH policy is misused. IPMS is monitored by GM personally. Performance observed for 6 months on transfer cases is not correct which would target the members. Change of place from CHTD to TLNG, Transfer case of Sri. Ramasubba Reddy,DS. DFS transfer to ATP (BA HQ) should be taken up at Circle office.

KURNOOL BA:

Last year Intra circle transferred candidate are not yet relieved so far. Mis-use cases on immunity was submitted. One-Network is not fully functional. Only CPAN & NOC is monitored and that too only 12 hrs. BSNL brand image is missing. Hoarding publicity should be given.

CS Closing remarks:

Intra circle transfer orders will be issued in the next week. Biased transfer orders will be objected. All misuse of immunity cases to be brought to the CEC notice. Meeting with the management should beneficial to both association & Organization. All the DS/DP should delegate the responsibility to all DEC members in driving the members. Making all DEC/CEC members involved would achieve good results & emerging new leaders. In view of this, the responsibility is proposed to be delegated as detailed below for better results.
